# CLIMBER'S GUIDELINES



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Here is our short code of conduct that will help the future sustainability and access of climbing for all user groups!

1

If you need to undertake a climbing introductory course. Find a mentor or an accredited operator. Safety first is a personal responsibility.

2

Respect QPWS officers, rangers and land holders, conservation parks or state forest lands.

3

If it's closed for danger or habitat conservation or bird nesting, stay out.

4

Respect all other visitors, tourists and climbers in the park or conservation area. Equal opportunity.

5

Take all your litter and pick up any litter you see. Leave the place better than you found it. Leave no trace.

6

Stay on the track. Protect the vegetation habitat and limit erosion issues.

7

Go to the toilet before you go to the crag. Do not poo at the crag!

8

If the crag is overly busy, consider another area nearby.

9

If you use tick marks and chalk, please, brush them off before leaving.

10

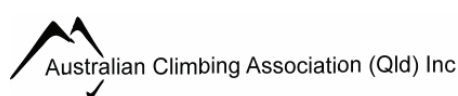
Do not mark, chip, or break any rock or manufacture holds. Leave for all to discover and enjoy as nature intended.

11

Park at designated parking. Car pool where you can. Remember how sound travels, leave the boombox at home.

12
